REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF FEBRUARY 2023

VISITS: During the month 7 visits were made to the member estates in connection with Advisory, trainings and experimental purposes.

WEATHER: The month February this year was a blend of cold and warm weather. The land wind happened few days during the month sweeps the moisture and dry spell experienced from the second fort night of the month. The last effective rain recorded at the regional centre was 11.4 mm on 14th December 2022. There after meager rains were recorded as 3.2 mm on 26th December 2022; 5.0 mm on 25th January 2023 and 1.0 mm a trace amount on 4th February 2023 as the last rain registered so far which is an indication that peak summer months are likely to be more serious than anticipated, unless the plantation taluks receive summer showers. From the last effective rain till this month end almost 75 days is the rainless period. The depletion in water level and temperature shooting up slowly now will have serious consequences like damages to the plants and crop loss going to be higher than usual years. Hence all precautionary measures should be taken to avert the damages to the plants. The minimum temperature recorded in the regional centre was 8 °C on four occasions and fluctuated between 8 °C to 16 °C. The maximum temperature fluctuated between 25 °C to 31 °C. The lowest relative humidity was 26per cent recorded at 2.30 pm and the highest registered was 91 per cent at 8.30 am during the month. The details of rainfall, temperature and relative humidity recorded for the month and decennial average in the regional centre, Gudalur are given in the following tables 1 & 2.
