### **REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF JANUARY 2023**

**VISITS:** During the month 13 visits were made to the member estates in connection with Advisory, trainings and experimental purposes.

**WEATHER:** During the month under report more number of days recorded with low temperatures compared to many years. Most of the days mist filled roads from late evening to morning and freezing feeling experienced. Due to the frosting Blister Blight disease infections are noticed in the prone pockets. The lowest temperature recorded was 6 °C on 14th, 16th and 17th of the month (three days). During the month 7 °C was recorded 4 days; 8 °C for 9 days; 9 °C for a day; 10 °C for 3 days; 12 °C one day; 13 °C for 2 days and 15 °C for a day, which indicates a direct correlation of retardation of shoot growth. The minimum temperature fluctuated between 6 °C to 15 °C and the maximum temperature oscillated between 23 °C to 29 °C. During the month the sky was downcast, grappled with high humidity at two days, it failed to open one day and the other day barely received 5.0mm rain in the regional centre. There was report from some of the zone that there were light to moderate isolated rains and at the same time it was scanty in few regions. Last year there was no rain during the month of January. The afternoon relative humidity fluctuated between 21 per cent to 91 percent and the morning relative humidity varied between 80 to 90 percent. The details of rainfall, temperature and relative humidity recorded for the month and decennial average in the regional centre, Gudalur are given in the following tables 1 & 2.
