REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF JUNE 2022

VISITS: During the month 9 visits were made to the member estates in connection with Advisory, training and experimental purpose.

WEATHER: The month June was typical and every day there was change a blend of snowy, drizzle, rain, sunny& warm weather experienced. The south west monsoon sets in from 5th of June and not vigorous as expected. There was no heavy rush crop due to the weather prevailed throughout the month, at the same time an average steady crop was harvested during the month. The total rainfall recorded for the month of June was very scanty 211.8 mm with 20 wet days and it was 238.0mm for the same corresponding month of last year with 18 wet days. The total rainfall for the calendar year is 664.4mm and for the same corresponding period of last year it was 590.0 mm (12.6% higher). The driest months of June in the past 40 years of record available in the regional centre reveals that this year June is also one of the below normal month. The minimum temperature fluctuated between 16 °C to 18 °C and the maximum temperature oscillated between 23.0 °C to 28 °C. The lowest relative humidity levels was 70 per cent and the highest registered was 100 per cent. The details of rainfall, temperature and relative humidity recorded for the month and decennial average in the regional centre, Gudalur are given in the following tables No.1 & 2.
