#### REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF SEPTEMBER 2022

**VISITS:** During the month 7 visits were made to the member estates in connection with Advisory, training and experimental purpose.

WEATHER: The intensity of south west monsoon rainfall has come down during the month. There was continuous rainfall for the first fortnight of September and comes to halt. Again after a gap of five days it rained on 20<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> and the rain tailed off. The foggy and low temperature weather hindered the growth of tea and crop production was not to the expectations. The total rainfall recorded at the regional centre for the month of September 2022 was 178.4 mm with 15 wet days whereas, for the same corresponding month of last year it was 271.8 mm with 14 wet days and 345.1 mm for the decennial average. The minimum temperature fluctuated between 15.0 °C to 18 °C and the maximum temperature oscillated between 21.0 °C to 29.0 °C. The lowest relative humidity levels was 51 per cent and the highest registered was 100 per cent. The details of rainfall, temperature and relative humidity recorded for the month and decennial average in the regional centre, Gudalur are given in the following tables No.1 & 2.
