### REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF MAY - 2023

**Visits:** During the month of May, seven visits were made to the member estates in connection with Advisory and experimental work.

**Weather:** The district experienced uneven distribution of rainfall during May. It was not sufficient to undertake pruning in estates. The Regional Centre experienced megre showers during the second and 4th week of May. The total rainfall received was 30 mm in 5 rainy days which was very low when compared to the corresponding period of previous year and the decennial average. The temperature recorded in the morning was between 19°C and 22°C whereas in the afternoon it varied between 31°C and 38°C. The morning relative humidity was between 83 & 100 % and in the afternoon it varied between 28% and 61%. The details of rainfall, mean temperatures and mean relative humidity per cent recorded at the Regional Centre, Koppa are given in table below.
