- : The early and intense monsoon is being driven by two weather systemone in the Arabian Sea and the other in the Bay of Bengal which are creating ideal conditions for heavy to very heavy precipitation. A depression has developed and monsoon has

strengthened due to the twin system this month. The rainfall from May 23rd to May 27th was accompanied with gusty winds. Clogged drains overflowed inundating roads; slush filled the roads much to the discomfort of motorists affecting traffic.
